

Our 10 point approach to Cleaning-up!

Please be patient while we prepare the surgery for your visit.

Your safety is our main concern and we have a strict protocol to follow to make a dirty surgery clean between patients!

1. We remove every instrument used on the previous person to a separate room to be cleaned and sterilised by our dedicated staff member.
2. We wash our hands and put fresh clinical gloves on to wipe down all the surfaces in the surgery. We use a specific disinfectant to kill bugs.
3. Everything we have previously used is disinfected and put away.
4. We wash our hands again.
5. Writing up your notes takes some time – Everything we have done to you and everything we have discussed is written down so we know what has happened and how you feel about your treatment
6. We may need to refer you to another health care professional and this requires prescriptive information passed to the other person to ensure your safety.
7. Your clinical notes are prepared on the computer, any previous x-rays are looked at and your medical history questionnaire is checked to make sure you're not taking any medication, which could affect what we do.
8. We wash our hands again, put fresh clinical gloves on and place plastic barrier covers on some surfaces to help protect you.
9. Sterilised equipment is prepared for your visit by selecting new packets containing the instruments we need for your visit.
10. We can now ask you to come inwelcome
